The Paint Your HeART Out class last week was not only therapeutic for me doing it, but I hope the end result is therapeutic for the patients as well.

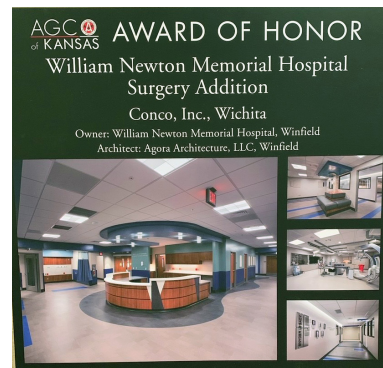

PAINT YOUR HEART OUT: MONET-STYLE

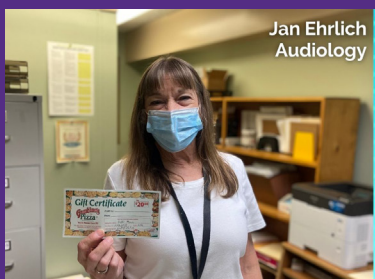
